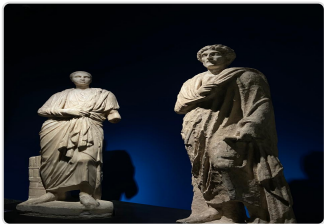

DAY 1 Alexandria Day tour

Meet your guide at the hotel lobby after your breakfast to be escorted for a 2.5-hour drive per way to embark on your historical Greco-Roman adventure and enjoy an amazing day tour in Alexandria. First, visit The Roman Theatre, the only known Roman Amphitheatre in Egypt, located in the modern area of Kom El-Dikaa. It is a well-preserved structure composed of thirteen terraces with marble seats for up to 800 spectators in the traditional Greek style. It also contains galleries, baths, Roman villas and a beautiful surrounding garden. Then, visit Pompey's Pillar. It was constructed in honour of Emperor Diocletian at the end of the 4th century. Originally from the Temple of Serapis, it was once a magnificent structure rivalling the Soma and the Caesarean. Lunch at a local restaurant in Alexandria will be a different experience in between the visits. Afterward, drive to visit The Catacombs, the largest Roman Cemetery consisting of three levels cut into the rock. A photo stop at the Citadel of Qaitbay. Finally, you will be transferred back to your hotel in Cairo. Meals: Lunch
