Highlights from Abu Simbel to Aswan

Abu Simbel Temples: Considered among the top attractions of Aswan and [Egypt tours](#). It has uncountable stories and legends that you should listen to yourself. Abu Simbel is located on the western bank of Lake Nasser & it's about 230 km southwest of Aswan near the border with Sudan.

It's a set of two temples, it was constructed for the pharaoh Ramses II and the other for his beautiful wife Nefertari. It was built in 1255 BC & it was rediscovered two hundred years ago. Stop at Abu Simbel temple to watch the two temples with [Lake Nasser cruises](#).

The larger temple is dedicated to three major Egyptian goddesses & features four large statues of Ramses II on its facade, while the smaller temple is dedicated to the love goddess Hathor, with statues designed for his beloved wife Nefertari.

Kasr Ibrim: this is like a museum because it contains the largest collection of Old Nubian documents ever found which was occupied until 1813 & today the island is closed because the site has been shot by artillery fire. Check the itineraries of [Egypt Nile cruises](#) that stop at Kasr Ibrim that deserve visiting.

The Temple of Amada: it's the oldest Egyptian temple in Nubia, was first constructed by Pharaoh Thutmose III of the 18th dynasty, and is dedicated to Amun and Re-Horakhty. His son and successor, Amenhotep II continued the decoration program for this structure.

The Temple of Kalabsha: is located on the Western Bank of the River Nile, around 40 miles south of Aswan on a hill near the High Dam site. This temple was originally built by Toutmosis II and Amenophis II and was restored during the Roman era.

After you finish your tours and attractions in Aswan, you can sail by a Nile [cruise between Luxor and Aswan](#) if you have more time in your vacation.
